WITH NOLDE BANZIGER AT WESTBROADWAY GALLERY

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- REGGIE HARRIS: "The exhibition is titled New York's buildings-illuminating images. It is the work of NOLDE BANZIGER, a Swiss native who sold electronic equipment before coming to paint in the big apple 4 years ago. Each of the 12 paintings show pieces of Manhattan as reflected by the city's glass and chrome architecture."
- NOLDE BANZIGER: "Since I'm here I was fascinated by the buildings and people in particular too. So far I started out with less people in it but as more the work developed the more people I have chosen to put into the whole pictures."
- REGGIE HARRIS: "BANZIGER says cities are the ultimate people hives and New York the ultimate city with a kind of magnetic draw which makes its inhabitants bold enough to take on the world. He tries to convey that message especially in the picture, I CAN DO IT!"
- NOLDE BANZIGER: "She's a kind of tough woman who faces I mean the reflected city in one of these chrome posts of the buildings-with the pose she has she looks as she could or couldn't take it on but I guess tough as she is she can take it and that shines in this whole picture itself."
- REGGIE HARRIS: "BANZIGER believes we all draw energy from the city that make us believe we can control our destiny's. He says everyday we see that image of ourselves in the city's mirrors --- the buildings. He has tried to capture it and we can have it for \$4,000.00 each. In Soho, REGGIE HARRIS NEWS 4 NEW YORK."
